

Play-Full Park is a new program that brings you recreational activities, infused with enrichment components. The twist is that participants don't have to leave their neighborhood to participate! Play-Full Park will be coming into the Cypress Village Neighborhood Park for the children in Cypress Village I and II on Saturdays.

In this neighborhood, there is a particular safety problem with children playing in the streets with traffic. Now that there is a new park in Cypress Village I that was built by the residents of Cypress Village as a community build project, neighborhood kids have a safe place to play and we want to help encourage the use of the new park. The program will offer at least 30 minutes of physical activity for all participants. The benefits of providing active opportunities for kids are these: strong muscles and bones, weight control, decreased risk of type 2 diabetes, better sleep, and a better outlook on life. According to the survey that residents of Cypress Village I and II completed, math and reading were the top two subjects in school that they felt their child needed help with. The TAKS test results for the last two years have indicated that those two subjects are the top priority at Massey Ranch Elementary as well. Math, reading and science will be covered separately during the program this summer.
